

According to the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services, a record-setting 36,528 organ transplants were performed in 2018 and over 113,000 candidates are currently waiting for a solid organ transplant.¹ Average billed charges (before negotiated contract rates) are increasing annually. In addition to the actual cost of transplantation, treatment and medication required pre- and post-transplant add to the overall cost.
